Stakeholder Notification/Public Notice

The land trust accreditation program recognizes land conservation organizations that meet national quality standards for protecting important natural places and working lands forever. The Golden State Land Conservancy (GSLC) is pleased to announce it is applying for accreditation this year. A public comment period is now open.

The Land Trust Accreditation Commission, an independent program of the Land Trust Alliance, conducts an extensive review of each applicant's policies and programs. Since 2000, GSLC has focused on generating real conservation outcomes for over 34,000 acres of land across California. GSLC wants to continue enhancing its pragmatic success by becoming an LTA accredited Land Trust.

The Commission invites public input and accepts signed, written comments on pending applications. Comments must relate to how GSLC complies with national quality standards.
